#### Meeting Minutes

6:00pm Call to order- Pledge of Allegiance

Members in Attendance- Mr. Vicchiariello, Ms. Dennison, Ms. Fuller, Mr. Siegel, Chief Worden.

Public Comment - No public comment received.

New Business

- Hiring- Police Officer Vacancies- Civil Service List- Committee was updated on the background investigation process and status of candidates currently being reviewed for potential hire to fill current vacancies within the police department patrol division.
- CompStat Report- The Committed was briefed on crime numbers for the month of January 2025.
- SNUG Grant Anti-Violence Programs -Women's Self-Defense The department is planning to host a Women's Self Defense Seminar during the month of March.
- Statistical Dashboard 2024 and end-of-year reports- The Committee reviewed the 2024 draft Annual Statistical Dashboard that contains a summary of vital statistical data concerning crime, enforcement, police activity and use of force incidents.
- Use of Force annual report The Committee reviewed 2024 Use of Force incidents reported in the annual report.
- Lexipol Grant The department obtained a grant of \$4,006.58 from PERMA to off-set the costs of the annual Lexipol policy and training subscription.
- Body Armor Grant- The department currently received body armor replacements for officers totaling \$6911.46 which will be paid for using a Dept of Justice Body Armor Grant and funding provided through PERMA.
- Chief Worden reviewed contingency plans being formulated for local police agencies to assist the NYSP through mutual aid in the event of a major prison disturbance occurring at Otisville Correction Facility.

#### Old Business

• Range Building – Update-The Port Jervis DPW and Town of Deerpark Highway Dept will be framing the interior portion of the training building within the next two weeks. DPW will install the rough in electrical and plumbing and quotes will be obtained from vendors to install drywall.



- License Plate Reader and Surveillance Camera Project Cradle Point technology is being ordered for installation at each License Plate Reader site with T-Mobile Air Cards to ensure reliable, seamless connectivity. Camera infrastructure for the city-wide project has been received, existing camera infrastructure from former system is currently being removed and we are working with DPW to install electrical outlets at the pole for the camera units.
- Accreditation NYS DCJS and Program Grant Chief Worden provided an update of the status of accreditation and provided examples of accredited policies and compliance to the committee for their review of the process.

### **Committee Comments**

Mr. Vicchiariello reviewed overnight parking and enforcement activities and discussed the overall lack of compliance during the recent snow storms. The Code Committee will be reviewing the current law.

Ms. Dennison reported tractor trailer traffic being routed on North Maple Avenue causing traffic congestion due to the North Maple Avenue railroad tunnel. Requested signed be installed to warn trucks.

Executive Session – Committed voted to enter into Executive Session at 6:34pm by request of the PBA to discuss a request to review contractual matters involving EAP and sick donations for employees. Committed ended executive session and reconvened the meeting at 6:50pm.


